Another year is coming to an end, and we continue to go from strength to strength. Our membership has now grown to 2,300 members, and we maintain a business network of 8,000+ in the West London Chamber community. This year, we have organised 80 events, including training webinars on AI and a trade mission to Atlanta! Alan has just returned from the Chambers' fourth trade mission this year to China. Following a highly successful mission to Atlanta with 26 businesses, our reputation for international trade is rapidly expanding. This is evidenced by the 40 international trade events we have held this year – and the count is still rising, with the last two attracting over 100 attendees each! What Alan does not know about international trade is not worth knowing!

We have also been busy locally, organising a wide range of events; there is something for everyone, so please come along and see us in action. As with all membership organisations, what you put in is what you get out. You also have the chance to meet the Chamber team, enabling us to learn more about your business and promote you and your endeavours. The Ealing Festival of Business in October was highly successful, with attendance doubling to 400. Building on this success, we are now planning a Festival of Business for Hammersmith & Fulham. The Women in Business events are always well attended. We also run a number of webinars on various topics; all are recorded and can be viewed on our YouTube channel.

We continue to collaborate with BITC (Business in the Community), focusing on the west side of Hounslow borough. Our greatest achievement this year is, following the lead of Hammersmith and Ealing Boroughs and with significant support from Fulham BID, that Hounslow Town Centre has elected our Chamber to run a BID (Business Improvement District) with a 98% majority in Hounslow's town centre. We have successfully launched Hounslow's Heart BID, the first in the borough of Hounslow. This initiative has been nearly 10 years in the making, and successfully bringing it to fruition is a major achievement, of which we are very proud. Hounslow's Heart BID will officially start on 1st December, and we thank everyone who contributed to making it happen.

We are proud members of the London Living Wage initiative and the Good Business Charter. These programmes are set to enhance social mobility across our boroughs.

We wouldn't be able to do all we do without the support of our team (Gerry, Samar, Kavin, Lisa, and Aya, whom we have transitioned from apprentice to full contract — our thanks to all of you), the support of our Board, and most importantly, YOU, our members. Tonight is your night; it is because of you and your businesses that we are here, working tirelessly to support you and celebrate YOUR success. We are stronger together, so please let us know how we can assist.
